




IHS51 Exhibitions: information for car drivers

IMPORTANT: SEND US YOUR VEHICLE LICENCE PLATE NUMBERS + DATE & APPROXIMATE TIME OF ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE

The venue of the exhibits (St-Baafshuis) is partly located in the restricted circulation zone of Ghent city zone. It is important to stick to the route indicated on this road map. St-Baafshuis has a large inner court where you can safely park for unloading. Move your vehicle to a public parking spot after unloading (see page 2).



Update your SatNav (GPS) system before coming to Gent! Older version might lead you through the restricted areas (indicated with red painted lines).

Parking in Ghent

All vehicles have to be moved from St-Baafshuis Inner court immediately after unloading.

Do not park on-street in the area of the St-Baafshuis/Conservatory, even for a short time.

You will be towed/fined within minutes! (min. 80€)

All on-street parking bays are strictly reserved to residents and police/city service vehicles.

Parking Option 1 (best): Enquire if your hotel has a parking garage

Parking Option 2 (close but expensive): Public parking garage "Reep" (address: Seminariestraat, Gent). Parking costs appr. 2,5€ per hour or 27€/day. 3 minutes walk to the conservatory

Parking Option 3 (cheap): park on-street in the 'orange' parking zone in the area of School of Arts Campus Bijloke (address: Kluyskensstraat and surroundings). 15 minutes walk and 6€/day. Enter your licence plate number in the machine and choose day tariff. You will need to renew your parking ticket every day.

Parking Option 4 (free): park on a P&R location near the motorway exits Gentbrugge or Expo, then take the tram to the city centre (20-30 minutes).

(Un)loading:

You can unload goods at the St-Baafshuis at any daytime hour from Monday 1 July onwards. Proceed to the reception in the entrance hall to check in. After this, you will be assigned a safe space to store your goods.

Students will be available to help you unloading/moving things during the setup times on Wednesday morning only. You will then be assigned your exhibition space by the Exhibits coordinator.

Exhibition tables can be cleared on Saturday evening 6 July 8pm-10pm and Sunday 7 July 8:30-11:00 and should be completely removed by Sunday 11:00.

You can drive your vehicle to the inner court during these times, however, overnight parking is strictly prohibited.
